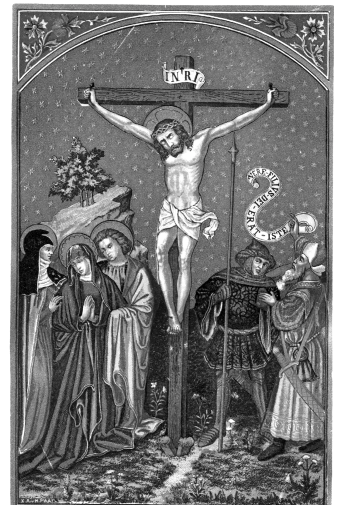

SANCTUS




